PE Kit

The Committee further discussed the new PE kit. Ideas such as different colour shorts and t-shirts were brought up. **Mrs Roberts** reminded the Committee that it could be unsafe to completely change the colour of the kit as teachers would find it harder to find pupils on outings such as the Lego Land trip.

Shay P liked the idea of different colour stripes on the t-shirts to distinguish between houses. Other ideas brought up were changing

the colour of the school emblem, adding the name of the house in its colour on the back of the t-shirt, and changing the colour of the t-shirt to a smarter colour – such as maroon to match the shorts.

Mrs Roberts suggested introducing school hoodies. There was overwhelming support for this from the Committee and the hoodies have now been introduced.

Sports Challenge
