### New Sports Award

## School Motto and Logo

The school has decided to go with **Harry Booth's** motto 'Respect All, Fear None', and **Sienna Radia's** logo. The Committee have decided both the motto and the logo will be printed on the back of the new PE kit.

## PE kit

The Committee will be presented with a mock-up of the new PE kit with the house colour strip on the sleeve and the Committee will decide if it will go forward.

## Sports Challenge

**Mrs Roberts** showed the committee her prototype booklet for the Sports Challenge which the Committee liked. The Sports Challenge will run across the whole school year, possibly even several years, and the children will earn an Olympic ring as per the following:

- Blue ring: 25 hours
- Yellow ring: 75 hours
- Black ring: 150 hours
- Green ring: 200 hours
- Red ring: 300 hours

Physical activity (PE, Fitter Future, etc.) in school will count towards these hours. Hours will be recorded on a daily basis and will be totalled each week. Daily and weekly hours require a signature from the teacher/sports coach leading the sessions. After achieving a ring, the pupil will be awarded a coloured certificate. The Committee discussed what the reward should be after completing the whole challenge. **Katie W** suggested the reward could be the new sports logo as a badge, **Amelie M** suggested the Olympic rings as a badge,

and **Orion M** likes the idea of a gold medal. **Mr Trevett** will look into different kinds of badges and medals. **Anya V** thinks it would be a good idea to have the names of pupils who have completed the challenge up on the Sporting Achievements display board. These ideas will be discussed further in the next meeting.

The Committee have agreed the Sports Challenge will be officially set up after Easter.
