Pupil survey

Mr Trevett went through the analysis of the pupil survey with the committee. The analysis displayed very high scores, with **Year 1 being the most happy with PE**, scoring 9.3/10. The lowest was Year 3 – scoring 7.1/10. According to the analysis, **pupils also thought there weren't enough PE lessons each week**. However, due to the survey taking place around Christmas time, much of PE had to be replaced by rehearsal time for plays. The survey also recorded the sports pupils wanted to do more -

with **tennis being the highest in demand**, followed by **gymnastics, Olympic field events, football, and swimming**. These points will be discussed further in future committee meetings.

Sports Challenge

Sports Challenge was discussed further. Luuk T suggested measuring how much sport we do by recording the amount of hours pupils do. Lexie thinks we should total the hours up on a termly basis, and pupils will get a reward for a certain amount of hours. The type of reward will be determined at the next meeting. As evidence of achieving these hours; Katie, Casey and Anya suggested having a photo of the pupil playing the sport, and a signature by the parent/coach. The Sports Challenge idea will be finalised at the next meeting.

Sports logo and motto

The committee have decided to set this as a homework task. The best ideas will be used as the school's sports logo and motto.

Permanent table tennis structures

Katie stated the equipment for table tennis may be a problem as it can get misplaced and broken easily. Nick suggested tethering rackets to the table, however Casey argued this could affect performance and it could be hazardous. Mrs Roberts informed the committee that the cost of a permanent table tennis will be between £1800 and £2200.

House colour PE kits

Katie wants to introduce coloured PE kits for house tournaments and sports day. Mrs Roberts thinks it would be best to do this at the end/beginning of a school year so parents have plenty of notice.
