I wanted to let you know what I would be learning over the next half term.

	Our narrative unit will focus on stories set in historical settings. Our Non-Fiction unit will focus on recounts.
	We will be learning about recounts and Myths and Legends. We are going to focus on the tale of Icarus and Daedalus.
	We will be learning about place value will extend this by learning in the context of money. We will be looking at using both mental and written strategies in addition and subtraction, as well as shape.
	We will be focussing on our sound unit. We will learn how sound is created and how the human ear listens and deciphers sounds. We will explore how sound waves are carried and will conduct a series of investigations to measure and record a variety of different sounds.
	In computing we will be focussing on researching accurately. We will be checking the accuracy and reliability of the information on the internet, using laptops and iPads. We will be using more than one source and begin to distinguish between fact and opinion.



	<p>In our outdoor PE learning, we will be focussing on football, and will learn the necessary skills and agilities required for the game. In our indoor PE learning we will be focussing on dance. This term on the 7th November, we will be given the opportunity to participate in a dance festival. This is a fantastic opportunity to showcase our creativity and dance skills.</p>
	<p>In History, we will be learning about changes in Britain from the Stone Age to the Iron Age.</p>
	<p>In French we will be learning about colours, days of the week and commonly used phrases around the school.</p>
	<p>In RE we will be introduced to Hinduism by exploring ways in which Hindus worship and finding out why worship is important to members of the Hindu community.</p>
	<p>In PSHE we will be learning about the different types of relationships, including those between friends, family, and marriage.</p>
	<p>In Music we will be learning poetry through music. We will be exploring a range of different sounds, and how they are made. This will be linked with our science learning.</p>
	<p>In Art we will be learning about viewpoints. We will be provided with the knowledge and skills to create the illusion of a viewpoint within our artistic examples. We will then extend our learning by practising proportion, placement and body shape.</p>
	<p>In DT we will be learning about the construction of mosaics. We will be exposed to a variety of different mosaic styles and examples, and will then construct our own creative designs.</p>
