Dear

I wanted to let you know what I would be learning over the next half term.

	Our narrative unit will focus on suspense stories. Our Non-Fiction unit will focus non-chronological reports.
	We will be focussing on the texts 'Murder at the Manor' and 'Space Attack'.
	We will be building upon prior knowledge in Maths and extending this by looking at place value and partitioning. We will also be looking at multiplication and division as well as time, fractions and shape. I will have many opportunities to develop my problem solving skills with an individual problem solving lesson each week.
	In our earth and space unit we will learn about the shapes and relative sizes of the Earth, sun and moon. Using models, we will learn how the three bodies move relative to each other and how these movements relate to night and day.
	In our HTML editors unit we will learn about the history of the web, before studying HTML (hypertext mark-up language), the language in which web pages are written. We will learn to edit and write HTML, and then use this knowledge to create a web page.



	<p>Throughout our gym sequences unit, we will perform new gymnastic moves with control and accuracy. We will recap on linking moves and understand how they will be used in developing sequences.</p> <p>In our invading unit, we will focus on the necessary foot and hand skills required in netball. We will develop skills in the range of passes, recognise which positions are attacking and which are defending, and learning how to successfully shoot.</p>
	<p>In History, we will be studying the Viking and Anglo-Saxon struggle for the Kingdom of England to the time of Edward the Confessor. We will have the chance to investigate and question history and formulate our own opinion.</p>
	<p>In French we will be learning the numbers 1-100, telling the time and parts of the body.</p>
	<p>In RE we will be learning about the life and teachings of Muhammad and develop our understanding of why he is significant for Muslims. We explore the idea of role models and how Muhammad provides a role model for Muslims. We explore the concept of revelation and religious experience, including the importance of quiet contemplation.</p> <p>This unit outlines the key beliefs and practices in Islam, emphasising current practice in addition to providing us with opportunities to learn about the historical foundation of the religion.</p>
	<p>In PSHE we will be looking to recognise conflicting emotions and when I might need to listen to my emotions or overcome them. We will recognise that increasing independence brings increased responsibility to keep myself and others safe.</p>

	<p>In Music we will be playing the ukuleles.</p>
	<p>In Art we will be learning about objects and meaning. In this unit we will select, arrange and present objects in a still-life painting. We investigate the work of artists who have used the theme of still life in a variety of ways to convey ideas and feelings. We will develop skills of observation and recording, and knowledge and understanding of colour, tone and composition.</p>
