June Review : **Saracens Tag Rugby Festival Thursday 6th June** – This year the Tag Rugby Team were entered into the Three Rivers and Watford District Tag Rugby Festival hosted by Saracens. 10 children from year 5 and 6 played amazingly well, winning 3 group games and drawing 1. We won our group and progressed into the quarter final. Here we faced tough opposition from Yorke Mead B and tied the game 2-2. The game went into extra time, golden try and we won! We then reached the semi final and played Harvey Road. The team were inspired by their quarter final win and won the semi final 4-3! We then played Yorke Mead A in the final. After a well balanced game there was nothing between the two teams. We remained determined and won the game 3-2 winning the entire festival and reaching 1st place out of 28 teams!

Tag Rugby Herts School County Games Thursday 27th June - As a result of winning our Tag Rugby district festival, the Tag Rugby Team progressed to play against the best teams in Hertfordshire. Sponsorship : Raising Money for Chorleywood Primary and St Mungo's (charity for the homeless): The PTA wanted to raise funds for the school to turn an old pavilion into a useable outdoor classroom. The children have all been involved and gave ideas on how they would like to use the classroom. The final decision was to use it for an outdoor Science classroom.
