## Middy Supervisory Assistants Still Needed

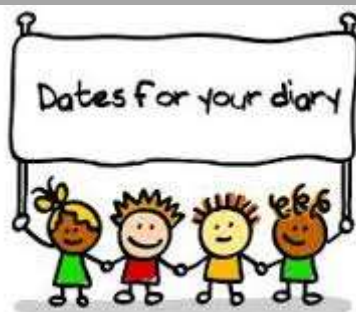


We are delighted to welcome Mrs Parmar to our lunchtime team from January!
