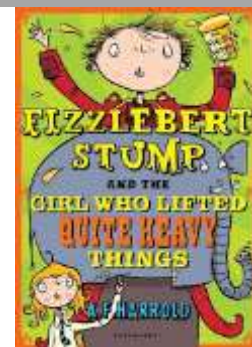

## Important Reminders



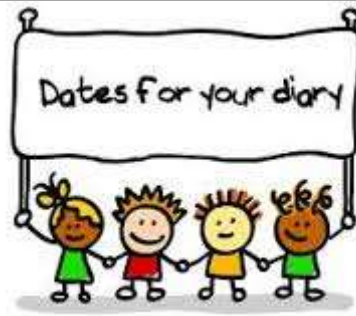
