They will be collecting donations towards helping those less fortunate in the local area this Christmas. Please see the attachment for information about dates and locations of the collections.

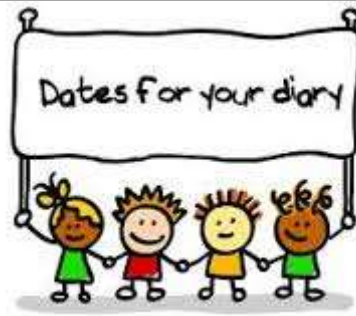
Midday Supervisory Assistants Needed
