Overall attendance for the 2015/16 year to date is 97.7.%.


Thank you to everyone for your support. Let's continue to keep this a focus for the rest of the term.


#### Year 5 Tri Golf Tournament

Exciting News! Chorleywood Primary School to grow seeds from space!

Chorleywood Primary School will be one of up to 10,000 schools to receive a packet of 100 seeds from space, which they will grow alongside seeds that haven't been to space and the differences measured over seven weeks. The pupils will not know which seed packet contains which seeds until all results have been collected by the RHS Campaign for School Gardening and analysed by professional biostatisticians.

In September, 2kg of rocket seeds were flown to the International Space Station (ISS) on Soyuz 44S where they will spend several months in microgravity before returning to Earth in March 2016. The seeds have been sent as part of Rocket Science, an educational project launched by the RHS Campaign for School Gardening and the UK Space Agency.


We hope that you are all finding our new communication and payment service 'School Gateway' easy to use!
