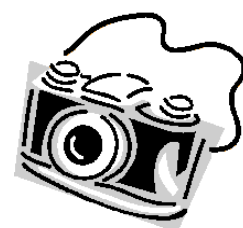


## Nursery Lunch Club

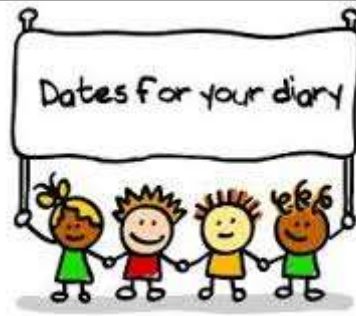


## Important reminders
