Tag Rugby Tournament

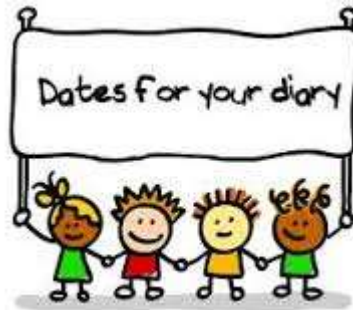
