## Poppy Appeal

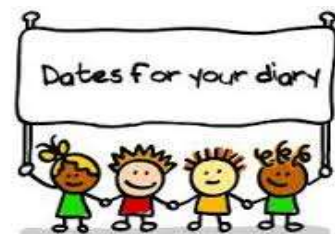
