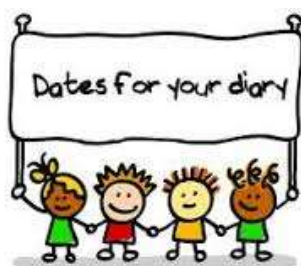
## Clean Air Day
